Work must be original, not a copy of another artist's work. Art must capture an image or images of Broward County waterways and may include canals, lakes and the Everglades. People, pets and wildlife images within this context are welcomed. Mediums may include oil, watercolor, pastel, and acrylic painting, mixed media, photography and collage. Maximum size: 11x17 inches. Work must be clean and ready for framing.

AWARDS

A group of local community leaders and art lovers will be serving as Jurists and will select the winners from those entries accepted for exhibition. U.S. Savings Bonds will be awarded to first, second and third place and a merit award. There will also be a People's Choice Award the night of the opening on Friday, April 20.
